Medications that are acceptable to take during a pregnancy



For Headaches:

Tylenol (Acetaminophen) Regular or Extra strength

For Colds, Cough, Congestion or Allergies:

Sudafed
Chlor Trimeton
Diemetapp
Robitussin- Plain or DM
Claritan or Zyrtec

For Constipation:

Metamucil Fiber Con Colace Senokot

For Heartburn or Indigestion:

Tums
Maalox- tablets or liquid
Mylanta- tablets or liquid
Sodium Free Rolaids

For Yeast Infection:

Any over the counter preparations- recommend Monistat

For Diarrhea:

Kaopectate

During pregnancy, expectant mothers may experience some of the typical problems noted below. The following over the counter medications available at most pharmacies may be used.
